Why do Wigan LA need our support?

"Did you know 28% of 4-5-year-olds are Overweight and Obese (That's approximately 10 pupils in a class). By the age of 10 and 11 over 40% of children are Overweight and Obese (That's nearly half the average class).

Attendance Matters

As you know we have a huge emphasis on the importance of great school attendance. The last few weeks before Christmas, saw a rise of coughs, colds and viruses. Going forwards though, we are determined to return to the previous excellent attendance and we're sure our families will join us in making this a key priority.

The world is run by those who turn up.

Attending school every day = 100% attendance

Attending 4½ days a week = 90% attendance = 4 weeks missed per year

Attending 4 days a week = 80% attendance = more than half a term missed per year.

Attending $3\frac{1}{2}$ days each week = 70% attendance = more than a quarter of the school year missed.

An average attendance of 80% or less across a child's school career adds up to missing a whole 2 years from school.

Being late for school reduces learning time.

If your child is 5 minutes late every day they will miss three days of learning each year

If your child is 15 minutes late every day they will miss 2 weeks of learning each year.

Make every minute count!
