#### CALENDAR - SAINTS OF THE WEEK

9<sup>th</sup> July – St Augustine Zhao Rong: The Chinese Martyrs who died between 1648-1930. Augustine was a Chinese diocesan priest. Having been a soldier who accompanied a priest, he was moved by his patience and had asked to be baptised; he was sent to the seminary and ordained. Arrested, he suffered the most cruel tortures and died in 1815.

11<sup>th</sup> July – St Benedict: The "Father of Western Monasticism". Born at Norcia in 480, he gathered followers in Subiaco before moving south to Monte Cassini in 529; here he founded his most famous monastery, and composed his Rule, still the indispensable guide to the Benedictine Order. He died in 547, on the 21<sup>st</sup> March. Today's feast is the anniversary of the translation of his relics.

#### **THOUGHTS**

From Praying Each Day by Brother Nicholas Hutchinson.

In 1980, Archbishop Oscar Romero was shot dead as he was celebrating Mass in a hospital chapel.

He was killed because he complained about the treatment of the poor by the government and the army. On this day, 8th July 1979, nine months before he was killed he talked about the witness of Christians, and he even used the phrase "If they kill your Bishop".

"If someday they take away from us our Catholic Radio Station, if they close down our newspaper, if they don't allow us to speak, if they kill all the priests and the bishops too and you are left - a people without priests - then each one of you must be God's microphone, a messenger, a prophet. The Church will always exist, even if there is only one baptised person. That one baptised person will be responsible, before the world, for holding up high the banner of the Lord' Truth and Justice."
