#### 28th Sunday

Each of the Scripture Readings this weekend shows the dramatic transformation of one who was once at the edge of a faith community but now brought into God's full circle. Naaman and the Samaritan leper are brought into full healing and community by

their gratitude to God.

#### 29th Sunday

In the First Reading we will hear about Moses raising his hands in prayer. The lifting up of arms and hands in the air is an ancient gesture of prayer and one that is still in use today. It is a physical illustration of the main theme of this liturgy: the need for perseverance in prayer.
