## <u>CALENDAR - SAINTS OF THE WEEK</u>

**28<sup>th</sup> Oct – SS Simon and Jude**: the name of Simon is placed eleventh in the list of Apostles and nothing is known of him, except that he was born at Cana and was known as the Zealot. Jude, also known as Thaddaeus, was the apostle who, at the Last Supper, asked the Lord why he showed himself only

to his disciples and not to the whole world (John 14.22).

St Jude is depicted in one of the stainedglass windows in Our Lady's Church, donated by the late Ted and Rita Handley to celebrate their Golden Wedding Anniversary.
